## **Our Mission & Vision**

Washington Area Women's Foundation is a communitysupported foundation that invests in the power of women and girls of color in the Washington DC region. We open doors to opportunity, safety and security through grantmaking and advocacy.

The Women's Foundation works to create economic opportunities that have positive ripple effects across society and open doors to progress. An open door can change a woman's life, and the lives of those around her. But not all doors are open to all women. That's why we won't rest until all women, especially young women and girls of color, have equal access to economic security, safety and opportunity.

## **Our Work**

Grantmaking: Using our deep expertise and insight into the needs of women and girls in the region, we are able to collect, direct and leverage resources so they support the most effective organizations and solutions working toward increasing economic security.

Since we were founded in 1998, we have:

- Invested over \$15 million in grants to more than 205 community-based organizations.
- . Helped over 16,000 women increase their income and assets by \$53 million through higher wages, decreased debt, tax credits, increased savings and growing equity related to homeownership
- With your support, we invested in organizations providing culturally specific support to survivors of sexual and domestic violence and worked with community partners to distribute cash assistance to care workers. In the Washington, DC region, each of these populations are more likely to be women of color and/or immigrant women.

Advocacy: We use our insight, expertise, and research to influence and activate our community, opinion leaders, and policymakers around the idea that when we take into account the needs of women and girls, we create opportunities for them to reach their full potential and for our community to prosper through their participation.
